Barbedienne accounts | 1871 :

"Carpeaux got first 1.000 Frs "for the composition and cares about the bust" then 348,5 Frs as "benefices part for the sale of L'Espiegle bust

sold at 2.800 Frs".

Marble block sale could be counted at 200 Frs.

Amounts for practioneers at 771 Frs."
